SUMMARY

The KCFHMP quides much-needed efforts

The KCFHMP guides much-needed efforts to fix an aging system of 500 levees and revetments that protect urban and rural floodplain residents, businesses, regional economic centers, public infrastructure and roads. The KCFHMP, adopted in 2006, is instrumental in achieving King County's high rating in the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Community Rating System under the Nation Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). This high rating has resulted in a discount of up to 40 percent on flood insurance areas for policyholders in unincorporated King County.

Proposed Ordinance 2013-0419 amends the KCEHMP in order to comply with NFIP requirements that the KCEHMP be updated by December 31, 2013, or the discount would expire. The revisions contain no changes to policy language. The revisions update information on flood and channel migration hazards, risks to people, property, and infrastructure, and the project accomplishments since adoption of the KCEHMP in 2006.
