The next meeting will be in November.

Ms. Lambert reported on her attendance at the Court Technology Conference. Attendance included members of juvenile court, superior court and district court. Many vendors with new technology ideas attended, and participants were able to look at their current ideas and get suggestions. Ms. Lambert indicated it was a very profitable and busy time.

Ms. Lambert gave an update on the recent board meeting of WSAC - Washington State Association of Counties. She indicated Councilmembers Dunn and McDermott were also in attendance. There was discussion about transportation and what could be done across the state. There was also discussion about sustainable funding and the members came up with a good sustainable package.

Mr. Dunn made remarks about Ms. Lambert's good leadership.

Ms. Lambert followed up with remarks about King County's different needs and commented that the Senate is having a listening tour in the Council Chamber on October 14, and all are invited to attend.
