AN ORDINANCE related to service fees to participants of the continuing legal education program provided by the department of judicial administration; and amending Ordinance 13330, Section 24, and K.C.C. 4.71.090.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A. Section 2 of this ordinance authorizes the department of judicial administration to assess a fee for participation in the department's continuing legal education program and to allow people who are not attorneys to participate.

B. The fee in section 3 of this ordinance is assessed as authorized under section 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. The department of judicial administration is hereby authorized to assess a fee to participants, attorneys and non-attorneys alike, in the department's continuing legal education program.

SECTION 3. Ordinance 13330, Section 24, and K.C.C. 4.71.090 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

The department of judicial administration is hereby authorized to assess a fee to ~~((attorneys who participate))~~ participants in the department's continuing legal education program. The fee assessed for participation in the program shall be ~~((one))~~ two hundred dollars to cover all costs of materials and presentation.

SECTION 4. This ordinance takes effect January 1, 2011.
