1 AN ORDINANCE establishing November 5, 2019, as the
2 date of a special election on the question of creating a
3 public hospital district on Vashon-Maury Island;
4 establishing the boundary lines of the proposed public
5 hospital district; and determining the number of
6 commissioners of the proposed district and the manner of
7 their election.

8 **STATEMENT OF FACTS:**

- 9 1. On April 22, 2019, a petition for the formation of a new public hospital
10 district in King County encompassing all the territory of Vashon-Maury
11 Island was filed with the King County director of elections. The director
12 of elections has examined the signatures on the petition, compared them
13 with the voter registration records of the King County department of
14 elections and certified their sufficiency in compliance with RCW
15 70.44.020 and 70.44.030.
- 16 2. The date and time for a hearing on the petition, along with the text of
17 the petition, without signatures, was published in the Vashon-Maury
18 Island Beachcomber on XXXX, 2019 and XXXX, 2019, in compliance
19 with RCW 70.44.030.

20 3. A public hearing on the properties to be included in the proposed
21 hospital district was held by the XXXXXX committee on XXXXXXXX,
22 2019, in compliance with RCW 70.44.030.

23 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

24 SECTION 1. The proposed public hospital district shall be known as the King
25 County Public Hospital District No. 5.

26 SECTION 2. The boundary lines of the King County Public Hospital District No.
27 5 shall be as follows:

28 The territory to be included in the proposed District is bounded from the
29 point on Vashon Heights at the Northeast corner of Government Lot 1,
30 Section 6, Township 25 North, Range 3 East W.M., by the meander line of
31 the low water marks of Puget Sound, starting East, thence South around
32 adjoining Maury Island, thence South around the Southern tip of Vashon
33 Island, thence North to the original point of beginning, following the
34 meander line of low water mark of Puget Sound at all times, and including
35 all docks, wharves and residences attached to said islands which may
36 protrude beyond the low water meander line. The boundaries of the
37 proposed District follow existing precinct boundaries and do not divide
38 any voting precinct, all required by RCW 70.44.030.

39 SECTION 3. In accordance with RCW 29A.04.321 and 70.44.020 a special
40 election is called for November 5, 2019, within the subject area of the proposition in
41 section 2 of this ordinance to consider the question of whether or not to form the King
42 County Hospital District No. 5 and to elect commissioners. The director of elections

43 shall cause notice to be given of this ordinance in accordance with the state constitution
44 and general law and to submit to the qualified electors of the district, at the special
45 election, the proposition hereinafter set forth. The clerk of the council shall certify that
46 proposition to the director of elections, in substantially the following form:

48 KING COUNTY WASHINGTON

49 The King County Council adopted Ordinance No. _____ concerning
50 the proposition to form King County Public Hospital District No. 5. This
51 proposition would authorize the formation of a new public hospital district
52 having the powers and duties in RCW 70.44.060. The new public hospital
53 district would encompass all territory of Vashon-Maury Island and would
54 be governed by a board of commissioners composed of five positions, all
55 of whom would be elected on an at-large basis.

56 For Public Hospital District No. 5 _____

57 Against Public Hospital District No. 5 _____

58 SECTION 4. The board of commissioners of King County Public Hospital
59 District No. 5 shall be composed of five positions to be elected on an at-large basis. The
60 initial commissioners for all five positions shall be elected at the November 5, 2019,
61 election.

62 SECTION 5. The director of elections is hereby authorized and requested to
63 prepare and distribute a local voters' pamphlet, in accordance with K.C.C. 1.10.010, for

64 the special election called for in this ordinance, the cost of the pamphlet to be included as
65 part of the cost of the election.
