

## Comments

The proposed neighborhood to be affected by this Ordinance is adjacent to two other neighborhoods which currently have similar time restricted parking zones. This Ordinance will expand the zone encompassing the existing parking restrictions.

Neighborhood complaints include:

Bothell High School commuters use the residential parking in the neighborhood.

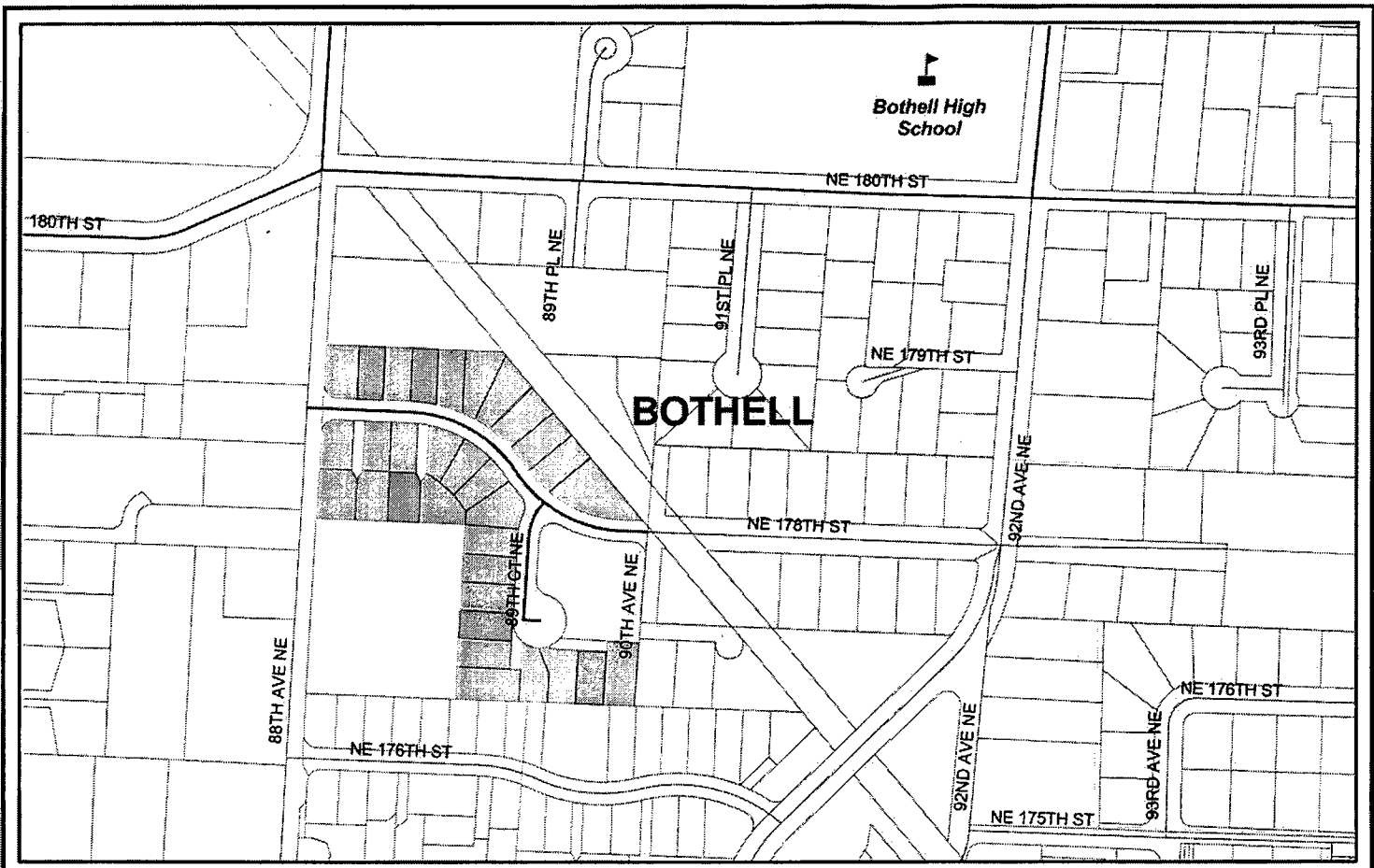
Mail cannot be delivered, and garbage cannot be picked up on occasion, due to students parking in front of mail boxes and garbage bins.

Due to parking on sidewalks, pedestrians, including children, are forced to walk in the travel lane.

There is increased burden on King County Sheriff's deputies who respond to citizen complaints regarding traffic infractions.

Excessive littering.

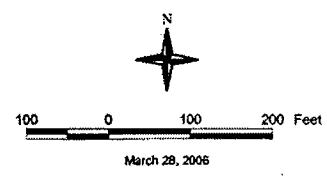

On behalf of the Woodside Heights Homeowners Association, located in King County, WA, I submit the following request to your department for consideration of the King County Council:

"The residents of Woodside Heights hereby submit a request for corrective measures to be implemented immediately in an attempt to resolve ongoing and potentially hazardous circumstances resulting from the misuse of our street and neighborhood by students of Bothell High School. Excessive speed and reckless behavior by the students is a daily occurrence when school is in session, putting the safety of our children at great risk. We jointly and respectfully request King County to post restrictive parking signs (i.e NO PARKING between 7AM and 2PM school days) on both sides of N.E. 178<sup>th</sup> Street between 88<sup>th</sup> Ave. N.E. and approx. 90<sup>th</sup> Ave. N.E. and both sides of 89<sup>th</sup> Ct. N.E., a cul de sac that joins N.E. 178<sup>th</sup> Street."

After consultation with your offices, as well as neighborhood meetings, the board of the Woodside Heights Homeowners Association recommended that the signs be posted. The 32 homeowners were polled and asked to submit a ballot showing their vote. I enclose ballots from all 32 homeowners (three are in email form). Of the 32 homes, 27, or 84.4%, voted in favor of the signs.

Based on this level of support, as well as further guidance from your office, we respectfully ask for your assistance in moving this process forward.


