An Interlocal Agreement for design, construction, ownership, operation and maintenance of the portion of Segment A of the Lake to Sound Trail that is within the City of Renton.

Under RCW 36.89.050, the County is authorized to construct a park or recreational facility and transfer to a city the County's ownership interest in that facility.
