1. Approval of Minutes April 9, 2007

2. Reports on Special and Outside Committees

Mr. Phillips reported on the recent meeting of the Sound Transit Board. He indicated the Board is continuing to work on a final set of recommendations to put before the voters in the fall, as a roads and transit package. The Board also reviewed a series of amendments to the plan.

Ms. Patterson briefed the Council on the Regional Transportation Investment District. The members will finalize the plan near the end of May. The plan will go before the full planning committee, which consists of every councilmember of King, Pierce and Snohomish Counties. Ultimately, the three legislative bodies of the 3 counties will place it on the November ballot. Ms. Patterson also commented on a recent Sound Transit poll regarding the draft roads and transit proposal.

Ms. Hague commented on the process of arranging a planning meeting of all members in order to approve the recommendations. Anne Noris, Clerk, will be contacting each member.
