1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2014-0166, VERSION 2**

2 On page 5, beginning on line 77, insert:

3 "By June 30, 2015, the division shall transmit an interim report to the council that  
4 describes the results of the contractor's efforts to achieve contract goals addressing  
5 participation rates of minority and women business enterprises in performing the work of  
6 this Factoria recycling and transfer station construction contract. By June 30, 2017, the  
7 division shall submit a final report. The interim and final reports shall identify the  
8 proportion of: minority-owned businesses participating as contractors on the project,  
9 against the ten percent minority business enterprise goal of the project; and the proportion  
10 of women-owned businesses participating as contractors on the project, against the six  
11 percent women-owned business enterprise goal of the project. The interim and final  
12 reports shall identify reasons for any shortfall in meeting interim or final goals, and  
13 describe efforts to overcome obstacles. The interim and final reports shall provide  
14 recommendations for achieving the identified participation goals of minority-owned  
15 businesses and women-owned businesses in future transfer station CIP projects. The  
16 interim and final reports shall also describe the participation levels of women and  
17 minorities in the contractor workforce of the Factoria recycling and transfer station

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18 construction project. The interim and final reports shall identify reasonable participation  
19 levels for women and minorities based on workforce availability and regional  
20 demographic representation levels. The interim and final reports shall make  
21 recommendations for achieving reasonable participation levels for women and minorities  
22 in future transfer station CIP projects. The interim and final reports shall further identify,  
23 for the Factoria recycling and transfer station construction contract: the proportion of  
24 minority and women apprentices performing all first year apprentice hours in all trades  
25 on the project, against the fifty percent goal for that category; the proportion of  
26 apprentice hours worked by minority apprentices in comparison to the goal of twenty-one  
27 percent of hours worked by minority apprentices; and the proportion of hours worked by  
28 women apprentices in comparison to the goal of twelve percent of hours worked by  
29 women apprentices. The interim and final reports shall describe the substance of the  
30 good faith effort undertaken to achieve these goals, and any obstacles encountered in  
31 achieving them, as well as efforts to overcome such obstacles. The interim and final  
32 reports shall make recommendations for achieving such goals on future transfer station  
33 CIP projects. The final report shall be accompanied by a motion acknowledging receipt  
34 of the report. The executive shall transmit the interim and final reports and the motion in  
35 the form of a paper original and an electronic copy to the clerk of the council, who shall  
36 retain the original and provide an electronic copy to all councilmembers."

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38 **EFFECT: This amendment requires an interim and final report that addresses the**  
39 **contractor's efforts to achieve goals for participation of minority and women-owned**  
40 **businesses among small contractors participating on the Factoria Recycling and**

41 *Transfer Station project. The report also is to address workforce participation levels of*  
42 *women and minorities on the Factoria project, and apprenticeship participation levels*  
43 *of women and minorities on the Factoria project. Recommendations for increasing*  
44 *participation by women and minorities on future transfer station projects are provided*  
45 *for. An interim report is required by June 30, 2015; a final report is required by June*  
46 *30, 2017.*
