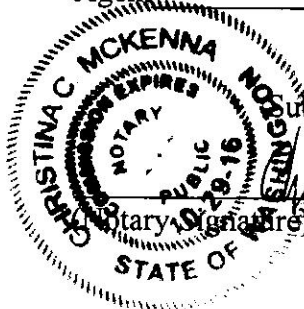

**NOTICE OF HEARING**  
Proposed Substitute Ordinance 2012-0441  
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council will hold a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle Washington) on Monday the 18th day of March, 2013 beginning at 1:30 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing is to consider adoption of Proposed Substitute Ordinance 2012-0441.

**SUMMARY**  
Proposed Substitute Ordinance 2012-0441 would: clarify provisions relating to forest practices; modify the definition of grading under the clearing and grading code; clarify actions that are exempt from the subdivision code; modify minimum construction requirements prior to recording of subdivisions; clarify provisions relating to separate lot recognition; modify requirements for complete applications and notice board requirements; modify zoning code definitions for materials processing facility and wrecked, dismantled, or inoperative vehicle and add definitions of floodplain development, forest management activity, forestry, livestock heavy use area, livestock manure storage facility, and temporary farm worker housing; modify provisions governing interim recycling facilities in RA zones; modify provisions governing timber and forestry retail and manufacturing uses; provide for temporary farm worker housing; allow increased density in A and RA zones for historic buildings; modify provisions relating to resource and open space tracts; modify critical area regulations related to vegetation management, new bridge construction, utility corridors and facilities, farm pads, and septic systems located in marine recovery areas; modify provisions governing farm plans; exclude from calculations under the critical area regulations areas located water ward of the ordinary high water mark; modify flood management regulations related to flood storage requirements, farm pads, and temporary farm worker housing; require a floodplain development permit for development activity in the floodplain; clarify activities not allowed as a home occupation; allow conservation futures levy funds for open space; allow in-water heat exchangers and simplify process for maintenance of agricultural ditches and waterways and clarify which proposed amendments affect the King County Shoreline Master Program and require subsequent state Department of Ecology approval. Some of the amendments will apply to areas within the shoreline jurisdiction subject to King County's Shoreline Master Program.
