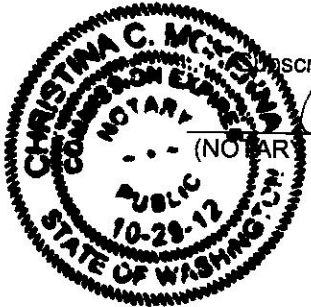

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA) on Monday, February 27, 2012, beginning at 1:30 p.m. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider Proposed Ordinance 2012-0041 (Ordinance 17267) adopting revisions to notice requirements.

SUMMARY:  
King County has chosen to provide for electronic public notice of minor (Type 1 decisions) for which a notice of application is not otherwise required under K.C.C. 20.20.060. In anticipation that a software program needed to implement the notice would be in place by June 2011, the electronic notice was to have begun on January 1, 2012. Due to delays, the software will not be installed until June 2012. Ordinance 17267 would extend the implementation deadline to January 1, 2013,
