Mr. Phillips reported on the Watershed Resource Inventory Area 8, a watershed encompassing the greater Lake Washington area. WRIA 8 is making great progress in salmon recovery. Mr. Phillips stated that 156 preservation and restoration projects have been undertaken, and many of them have been completed.

Mr. Phillips briefed the Council on the Sound Transit Central Link Oversight Committee. Mr. Phillips serves as Chair. The committee heard a progress report and update on construction. Mr. Phillips stated that overall construction is 85 percent complete on the link light rail system. The final

segment construction contract will be awarded in February. An update was provided on the airport link. It continues to progress on schedule, for completion in December, 2009.

Ms. Patterson reported on the first 2008 meeting of the Board of Health. The Board welcomed two new members, Nick Licata, City of Seattle and Councilmember Gossett, as a returning member. The Board passed goals and priorities, and its 2008 work plan. The Board also established a number of committees that will address specific issues, such as public health funding, hazardous waste, fee setting and nutrition partnerships with schools. The Board also heard an update on menu labeling. Ms. Patterson commended Public Health for its exceptional work.
