Data Center Relocation Project >>> project status

154 total devices, comprised of:

- √82 Moves
- √38 Decommissions

Next Steps: 14 additional Move Events planned for completion by the end of 2011



Data Center Relocation Project >> devices NOT moving

267 devices have been identified that will NOT be moved at the customer's request.

Justification:

- Proximity to function\direct connection
 - Some devices need to be near their business function, and it would not be cost effective to move them.
- Site specific
 - E.g., Active Directory Domain Controllers
- Video Systems
 - Surveillance
 - KCTV
- Disaster Recovery
 - Example: the 911 servers located at the Regional Communication and Emergency Coordination Center are physically tied to the E--911 equipment and removing these servers could jeopardize the 911 system.

Data Center Relocation Project Phase II >> move process

- Gather complete agency inventory
- 2. Agency kick-off meeting
- 3. One month planning meeting

Detailed requirements, testing plans complete

- Move scheduled
 - Resources Confirmed
- 5. Go/no-go meeting
- 6. Move Event
- Lessons learned



Data Center Relocation Project Phase II >> space utilization

- Sufficient resources available
- Completion planned for Q₄
 2011
- Ample floor space exists to add additional hosting capacity if required
