METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF ADOPTION

Ordinance 18791

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA) on Monday, September 10, 2018, beginning at 1:30 P.M. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2018-0312 (Ordinance 18791) an ordinance relating to the organization of County executive departments. The Council subsequently adopted the legislation on September 17, 2018.

SUMMARY:

Ordinance 18791 amends the King County Code to reflect the creation of a new department, the Department of Local Services. The Ordinance moves the existing Department of Permitting and Environmental Review into that department as the permitting division; the new Department of Local Services would also include a road services division and the community service area program. No substantive legal or policy changes are made with this ordinance, but other drafting corrections are included.
