Ordinance 18107

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on November 2, 2015 at 1:30 p.m.. The purpose of this public hearing is to receive public testimony relating to Ordinance 18107, which adopted findings in support of a moratorium and renewed for six months a moratorium on acceptance of applications for new development on isolated industrial zoned parcels. The moratorium does not apply to vested permit applications.

Background

Ordinance 18107 was adopted on September 8, 2015. A public hearing within sixty days of the enactment of a moratorium and the adoption of findings is required by RCW 36.70A.390. This hearing is only for public testimony on the moratorium and not for testimony regarding permits on any property or any potential rezone of industrial zoned property.
