6. Reports on Special and Outside Committees

Councilmember Patterson briefed the Council on the Puget Sound Regional Council Transportation Policy Board meeting. The Board received a briefing on the status of projects being funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. Seven transit projects and six highway projects have been completed The plan is to have all 38 highway projects and all 26 transit projects obligated by the year end deadline. The Board is ready to forward the transportation legislative agenda to the Executive Committee. They also received a status update on the Transportation 2040 Long Range Plan. The draft plan will be released to the public for review later this month.

Councilmember Patterson reported on the Sound Transit Board meeting. The board welcomed 4 new members and received a report on the 2009/2010 milestones for Sound Transit. In 2009, Sound Transit provided 18.6 million rides and broke ground on the Kirkland Transit Center. In 2010, Sound Transit will increase overall services hours by 17% and begin construction of light rail to the University district.
