4 in 2015, with an effective date of July 24, 2015, which became Chapter 102, Laws of
5 Washington 2015, and

6 WHEREAS, Chapter 102, Laws of Washington 2015 authorized King County to
7 issue debt against future lodging tax revenue for the purpose of creating affordable
8 workforce housing within one-half mile of a transit station, and

9 WHEREAS, the King County executive has drafted the Transit-Oriented
10 Development Bond Allocation Plan outlining how bond proceeds will be invested in
11 workforce housing projects throughout King County;
