In accordance with the Washington State Growth Management Act, King County hereby notifies the Department of Commerce (DOC) of its intent to amend the King County Code relating to the Transportation Concurrency Management Program. This notice revises the notice I sent to the DOC on August 26, 2011.

The King County Executive is proposing an ordinance to amend King County's Transportation Concurrency Management Program (enacted by King County Code 14.70) by adopting an update to the Transportation Concurrency Travel Shed Boundaries map and related code text changes. There is no process change being proposed at this time. The new proposed ordinance and map are attached, and electronic files will be sent to you shortly.

The King County Executive will transmit this proposed ordinance to the King County Council in September 2011. I anticipate the proposed ordinance will be acted upon by the King County Council in the fall of 2011. The ordinance can be tracked on the following website:
