Proposed No. 2003-0471.1 Sponsors Phillips 1 AN ORDINANCE increasing the service fee for adoption studies and marriage reconciliation charged by the family 2 court services division of superior court as authorized under 3 4 RCW 26.12.220; and amending Ordinance 6241, Section 2, 5 as amended, and K.C.C. 4.72.020. 6 7 8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: 9 SECTION 1. A. Section 2 of this ordinance increases the service fee for 10 adoption studies and marriage reconciliation services from eighty to one hundred dollars 11 per hour. 12 B. These fees are authorized by the legislative authority of any county as allowed by RCW 26.12.220. 13 14 SECTION 2. Ordinance 6241, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 4.72.020 are each hereby amended to read as follows: 15 16 Fee schedule.

17	A. The superior court shall prepare and adopt a fee schedule charging no more
18	than ((eighty)) one hundred dollars, per hour, for:
19	1. Adoption services, including:
20	a. confirmation of birth parent consent reports in all independent nonagency
21	adoptions;
22	b. stepparent adoption reports; and
23	c. other services as ordered by the court((-)); and
24	2. Dissolution services including:
25	a. mediation and evaluation orientation;
26	b. mediation services;
27	c. conciliation services;
28	d. dissolution one and two party evaluations;
29	e. witness fees for court testimony provided by family court services staff;
30	f. paternity services including evaluations; and
31	g. marriage waivers.
32	B. The department of judicial administration, clerk of the superior court and
33	superior court, having fully complied with K.C.C. chapter 2.98, are authorized to
34	implement procedures, for cause, to waive all or part of the fees based on an applicant's
35	showing of bona fide hardship. Collection of the service fee shall be the responsibility of
36	superior court and the department of judicial administration. Should it prove necessary,
