Ms. Patterson reported on the Executive Finance Committee indicating that at the April 28 meeting the committee received a briefing on the status of the county's investment portfolio. This is a quarterly briefing and an opportunity for a third party to review the portfolio and make recommendations and changes. Among other comments, the committee learned that the investments in the pool are of very high credit quality.

The Chair informed the Council that the Executive has indicated there will be one at-large vacancy on the Harborview Medical Center Board of Trustees effective on July 31, 2010. At this time in accordance with Ordinance 15548, the Chair is seeking nominations from all councilmembers for this vacancy and requested that he receive nominations in writing by Friday, May 14. He will inform the members of the nominations received at the Monday, May 17 Council meeting. He will subsequently submit the list of nominations to the Executive, who has the appointment authority. The Executive's appointment is subject to Council confirmation at a later date.
