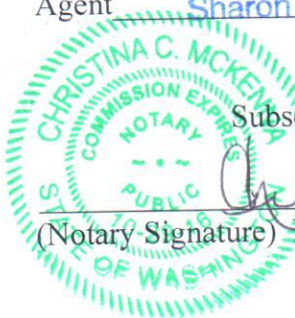

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 27th day of June, 2016, at 1:30 p.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2016-0249 authorizing the executive to approve the King County Open Space Plan: Parks, Trails and Natural Areas, 2016 Update.

SUMMARY

The King County Open Space Plan: Parks, Trails and Natural Areas, 2016 Update builds upon the legacy of previous plans to provide a framework guiding the King County Parks and Recreation Division in the planning, acquisition, development, stewardship and management of its complex system of 200 parks, 175 miles of regional trails, and 28,000 acres of open space. The plan reflects the many changes the division has undergone over the last decade and reconfirms the agency's mission and goals for providing and stewarding regional active and passive parks, trails, natural area parks, local rural parks and forest lands to provide recreation and environmental benefits to residents of King County and visitors. The adoption of the plan is a requirement of the Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) in order to be eligible for state and federal grant funding. An adopted plan must be received by the RCO by June 30, 2016, in order for the county to be eligible for the 2016 grant cycle, which determines grant recipients for the 2017-2018 biennium.
