1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2021-0093, VERSION 2**

2 On page 6, line 117, after "median family income; and" strike "limited access" and insert
3 "low-supermarket-access"

5 On page 6, line 121, after "identify low-income and" strike "limited food access" and
6 insert "low-supermarket-access"

8 On page 9, line 183, after "M." insert "'Low-supermarket-access census tract" means a
9 census tract that has been identified by the USDA food access research atlas as having at
10 least five hundred people or thirty-three percent of the population living more than one
11 mile in urban areas or ten miles in rural areas from the nearest supermarket or large
12 grocery store. According to the USDA food access research atlas, a census tract is
13 considered rural if the population-weighted centroid of that tract is located in an area with
14 a population of less than two thousand five hundred; all other tracts are considered urban
15 tracts.

18 On page 11, after line 231, insert:

19 "E. For the purposes of this ordinance a grocery business located in
20 unincorporated King County is exempt from this ordinance if:

21 1. The exempt grocery business is located in a low-supermarket-access census
22 tract; and

23 2. The nearest grocery business satisfying the requirements of subsection A.
24 through C. of this section is over three and one-half miles from the exempt grocery
25 business."

27 **EFFECT prepared by *Mary Bourguignon*: The amendment would exempt from the**
28 **requirements of the ordinance a grocery business location that is:**

- 29 • **Located in a low-supermarket-access census tract, which is defined as a**
30 **census tract in which 500 people or 33 percent of the population is more than**
31 **one mile from a grocery store in an urban area or more than 10 miles in a**
32 **rural area: and**
- 33 • **Over 3.5 miles from the closest grocery business location that would satisfy**
34 **the terms of the ordinance.**
