6	STATEMENT OF THE FACTS
7	1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of M. E.
8	Ely Road hereinafter described.
9	2. The department of transportation notified the various utility companies
10	serving the area and has been advised that all necessary easements have
11	been acquired within the vacation area.
12	3. The department of transportation records indicates that King County
13	has not been maintaining M. E. Ely Road. The records indicate that no
14	public funds have been expended for its acquisition.
15	4. A portion of an existing house encroaches onto the M. E. Ely right-of-
16	way. This house is owned by Gary Kawasaki and Shirley Naganawa who
17	support the vacation petition. The proposed vacation area encompasses

18	this encroachment. In a separate private agreement the encroachment
19	issue will be addressed between the petitioner and the home owners.
20	5. The department of transportation considers the subject portion of the
21	right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the
22	public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax
23	rolls.
24	6. The right-of-way is classified as "C-Class" and, in accordance with
25	K.C.C. 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty
26	percent of the assessed value of the subject right-of-way which was
27	determined from records of the department of assessments. King County
28	is in receipt of \$1,224.72 from Gary Kawasaki and Shirley Naganawa.
29	Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was
30	held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 16th day of April, 2003.
31	In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation,
32	the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of
33	King County to grant said petition.
34	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
35	SECTION 1. The council, on the 12th day of May, 2003, hereby vacates and
36	abandons that portion of M. E. Ely Road as conveyed to King County by with the

44	westerly margin, 20 feet to the true point of beginning; thence S 15
45	17'W, 103.2 feet; thence S 89 45E, 10.35 feet; thence N 15 17E,
46	103.2 feet; thence N 89 45 W, 10.35 feet to the true point of
47	beginning.

# NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL AND ADDITIONAL ACTION REQUIRED

In order to appeal the recommendation of the Examiner, written notice of appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council with a fee of \$250.00 (check payable to King County Office of Finance) on or before May 1, 2003. If a notice of appeal is filed, the original and 6 copies of a written appeal statement specifying the basis for the appeal and argument in support of the appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on or before May 8, 2003.

Filing requires actual delivery to the Office of the Clerk of the Council, Room 1025, King County Courthouse, 516 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Seattle, Washington 98104, prior to the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on the date due. Prior mailing is not sufficient if actual receipt by the Clerk does not occur within the applicable time period. The Examiner does not have authority to extend the time period unless the Office of the Clerk is not open on the specified closing date, in which event delivery prior to the close of business on the next business day is sufficient to meet the filing requirement.

If a written notice of appeal and filing fee are not filed within 14 days calendar days of the date of this report, or if a written appeal statement and argument are not filed within 21 calendar days of the date of this report, the Clerk of the Council shall place a proposed ordinance which implements the Examiner's recommended action on the agenda of the next available Council meeting. At that meeting, the Council may adopt the Examiner's recommendation, may defer action, may refer the matter to a Council committee, or may remand to the Examiner for further hearing or further consideration.

Action of the Council Final. The action of the Council on a recommendation of the Examiner shall be final and conclusive unless within twenty-one (21) days from the date of the action an aggrieved party or person applies for a writ of certiorari from the Superior Court in and for the County of King, State of Washington, for the purpose of review of the action taken.

The Examiner does not have authority to extend the time period unless the Office of the Clerk is not open on the specified closing date, in which event delivery prior to the close of business on the next business day is sufficient to meet the filing requirement.

If a written notice of appeal and filing fee are not filed within 14 days calendar days of the date of this report, or if a written appeal statement and argument are not filed within 21 calendar days of the date of this report, the Clerk of the Council shall place a proposed ordinance which implements the Examiner's recommended action on the agenda of the next available Council meeting. At that meeting, the Council may adopt the Examiner's recommendation, may defer action, may refer the matter to a Council committee, or may remand to the Examiner for further hearing or further consideration.

Action of the Council Final. The action of the Council on a recommendation of the Examiner shall be final and conclusive unless within twenty-one (21) days from the date of the action an aggrieved party or person applies for a writ of certiorari from the Superior Court in and for the County of King, State of Washington, for the purpose of review of the action taken.
