1 A MOTION appointing committees to write the voters'
2 pamphlet statements for the August 1, 2023, special
3 election regarding Ordinance 19604 providing for the
4 submission to the qualified electors of King County at a
5 special election to be held in King County on August 1,
6 2023, a proposition authorizing a property tax levy in
7 excess of the levy limitations contained in chapter 84.55
8 RCW for a consecutive six-year period at a rate of not more
9 than ten cents per one thousand dollars of assessed
10 valuation in the first year, and limiting annual levy
11 increases to three and one-half percent in the five
12 succeeding years, all for the purpose of supporting veterans
13 and military servicemembers and their respective families;
14 seniors and their caregivers; and resilient communities in
15 King County by funding regional health and human
16 services and capital facilities to promote housing stability,
17 healthy living, financial stability, social engagement and
18 health and human services system improvements and
19 system access; providing for a resident advisory board; and
20 directing proposal of an implementation plan for the

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21 veterans, seniors and human services levy, contingent upon
22 voter approval of the levy.

23 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of
24 local voters' pamphlets in conformity with chapter 29A.32 RCW for elections held in
25 King County, and

26 WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides for each measure from a jurisdiction that
27 is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall
28 formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the
29 measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure,
30 and

31 WHEREAS, Ordinance 19604 providing for the submission to the qualified
32 electors of King County at a special election to be held in King County on August 1,
33 2023, a proposition authorizing a property tax levy in excess of the levy limitations
34 contained in chapter 84.55 RCW for a consecutive six-year period at a rate of not more
35 than ten cents per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation in the first year, and limiting
36 annual levy increases to three and one-half percent in the five succeeding years, all for
37 the purpose of supporting veterans and military servicemembers and their respective
38 families; seniors and their caregivers; and resilient communities in King County by
39 funding regional health and human services and capital facilities to promote housing
40 stability, healthy living, financial stability, social engagement and health and human
41 services system improvements and system access; providing for a resident advisory
42 board; and directing proposal of an implementation plan for the veterans, seniors and
43 human services levy, contingent upon voter approval of the levy;


