Earlier this year, the 2025 Washington State Legislature passed Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill (ESSB) 5814, which added new business activities to the definition of retail sales. As a result, Seattle Times Media Solutions will be required to begin collecting sales tax on Advertising services listed below starting Oct. 1, 2025.

Note that all advertising in Seattle Times products, including promotion related to Branded Content, is exempt from sales tax, per RCW 82.04.214.

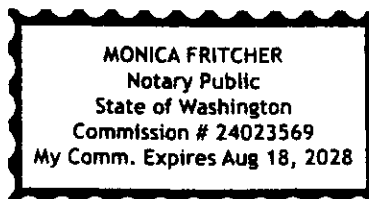

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council on April 21, 2026, at 1:30 p.m. The purpose of this public hearing is to receive public testimony relating to Ordinance 20041, which adopted findings in support of, and adopted for one year, a moratorium prohibiting the establishment of new or expansion of existing detention facilities, and required a study to address the issues and circumstances necessitating the moratorium.

The public hearing will be held at the King County Courthouse, 516 3rd Avenue, Room 1001, Seattle. Remote public testimony on Zoom will also be accepted. Written public testimony will be accepted from 9 a.m. on March 20, 2026, through 10 a.m. on April 21, 2026, by sending such public testimony to clerk.council@kingcounty.gov. Please include the legislation number and related agenda item in the subject line. Background

Ordinance 20041 was adopted on March 3, 2026. A public hearing within sixty days of the enactment of a moratorium and the adoption of findings is required by RCW 36.70A.390. This hearing is opportunity for public testimony on the moratorium.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing on Tuesday, February 24, 2026, beginning at 1:30 PM to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2026-0014 (Ordinance 20038), an ordinance authorizes the Executive to enter into a housing cooperation agreement with the Housing Authority of the County of King. The Council adopted this Ordinance at the Tuesday, February 24, 2026, meeting.

SUMMARY:
The Ordinance authorizes the Executive to enter into a housing cooperation agreement, which is allowed under chapter 35.83 RCW. The housing cooperation agreement concerns development of a property in the Skyway-West Hill geography of unincorporated King County, and includes a mobile home park/manufactured housing community on the Property consisting of approximately 30 homes affordable to households earning 80% AMI or less. The housing cooperation agreement modifies certain County development standards, including on-site tree replacement, minimum street setbacks, projections into setbacks, recreation area dimensions and configurations, recreation facilities and children's play area, solid waste and recyclable storage points and design, fences, landscaping, and off-street parking.
