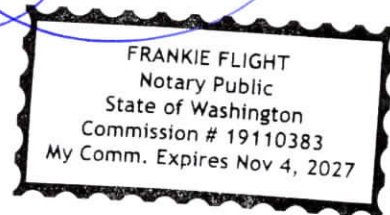

A remote public hearing before the King County Hearing Examiner will be held on **Wednesday, February 7, 2024, at 10:00 a.m.**

Please allow sufficient time in advance of the hearing start time to navigate traffic, find parking in busy downtown, and to move through Courthouse security. Note that animals are not allowed at the hearing location.
