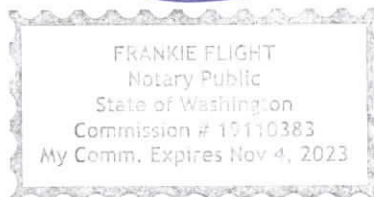

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
2020-0243

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council on the 19th day of October, 2021, at 1:00 p.m. to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2020-0243, an ordinance relating to construction and demolition waste; authorizing the Executive to enter into agreements for the disposition of construction and demolition waste generated within the county's jurisdiction; and prescribing penalties. The public hearing is planned to be held remotely to comply with the Washington State Governor's Declaration 20-28 (or as amended) regarding the Open Public Meetings Act. It is expected that the full Council will take action on this Proposed Ordinance at the October 19th, 2021 meeting following the public hearing.

SUMMARY

King County is proposing this ordinance to:

- Add language to the construction and demolition (C&D) waste code (K.C.C. 16.30) placing explicit responsibility on the generators, handlers, and collectors of C&D waste to send C&D waste loads to the proper C&D receiving facilities, and including language in code describing the specific conditions for delivery of C&D waste to transfer facilities, intermodal facilities, and landfills. A C&D receiving facility means any properly licensed or permitted facility that is designated by the county as the facility to which C&D waste, including residual C&D waste, is required to be delivered under the code.

- Expand the definition of C&D receiving facilities to include intermodal facilities and landfills, but limit use of said facilities to "eligible C&D demolition projects" in accordance with a waste diversion plan approved by King County. Under the proposed ordinance, only nonrecyclable C&D waste would be allowed to be sent to C&D receiving facilities that are intermodal facilities or landfills. Any person violating the conditions for use of intermodal facilities and landfills, in the director's sole discretion, may be prohibited from delivering or ensuring delivery of nonrecyclable C&D waste directly to a C&D receiving facility that is an intermodal facility or landfill for a period not to exceed six months; and

- Authorize the Executive to enter into Designated Facility Agreements with C&D receiving facilities using an updated agreement template containing provisions for intermodal facilities and landfills.

Final Action:

Prior to final action, Councilmembers may offer additional amendments for consideration by the Council. Persons wishing to testify on the Proposed Ordinance should virtually attend the public hearing on October 19, 2021.
