Proposed Ordinance 2012-0238

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 24th day of September, 2012, at 1:30 p.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2012-0238.

Proposed Ordinance 2012-0238:

- Describes the King County bicycle locker program and purpose in the ordinance preamble.
- Establishes the maximum on demand bicycle locker fees at King County transit passenger facilities.
- The basic fee is set at a maximum of \$0.10 per hour. This fee is charged to individuals using on demand bicycle lockers.
- The King County Department of Transportation is given the authority to set the rates, up to the maximum rate, based on a variety of factors including demand, location and time of day.

This notice is given in accordance with the provisions of RCW 36.32.120 (7) and provides penalties for the violation of the provisions thereof. It is available on the Internet at http://www.kingcounty.gov/council/clerk/ordinances_advertised.aspx
