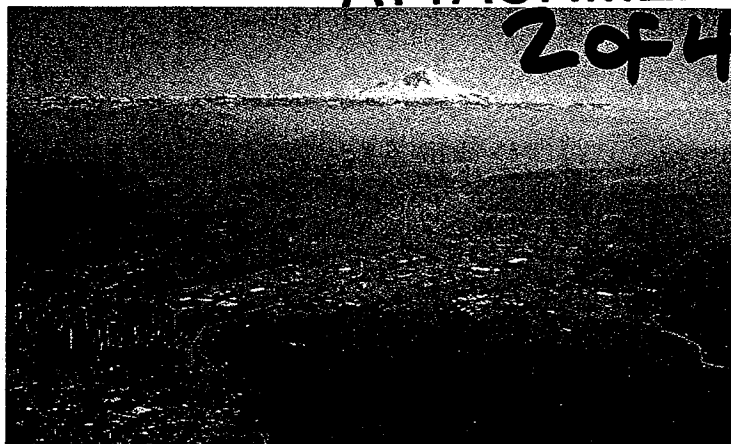

About King County

King County provides regional services to all residents of the county, including people who live in cities. These include public transit, sewage disposal, the county jail, elections, public health services, and regional parks. In unincorporated communities, King County provides the services listed above in addition to many local services, such as land-use regulation, building permits, solid waste disposal, and roads. Other local services in unincorporated communities are provided by fire, water, library and hospital districts that operate independently of county government.



The measures in this report are only a portion of those monitored and reported by King County. These measures represent the diversity of county services and were included based on input from a group of county residents.
