King County EDI Concept

- Invest early in community-driven development projects led by Community Based Organizations (CBOs) representing priority communities
- Provide capacity building <u>and</u> capital resources
- Fund projects that increase housing and community stability, expand access to opportunities, and build community wealth



EDI Concept: Shovel Hungry to Shovel Ready



A King County EDI would help small CBOs move from **"shovel hungry"** to **shovel ready**" by providing early investments in:

- organizational capacity building
- project development
- predevelopment activities
- site acquisition

"Shovel hungry" CBOs have strong project vision but need capacity and support to start the project.

"Shovel ready" CBOs are ready for construction financing.



Analysis of Near-Term Feasibility of CPW Recommendations

Implementation is not feasible beyond the \$1M proviso

No current fund source can meet the scale of need identified by CPW

State action and new revenue is needed



\$1 Million Proviso Estimated Costs over 18 Months

Operating Costs (\$264,174)

- One new Term-Limited Temporary (TLT) staff position and consultant
- Activities convene an interim EDI Advisory Board and implement new 12-month capacity building grants

Program Costs (\$735,826)

 Capacity building grants, Interim Advisory Board compensation, grantmaking committee compensation, language access services

September - December 2025	 Release capacity building RFP Recruit and orient RFP Grantmaking Committee
January - June 2026	 Conclude RFP process and announce capacity building awards Execute capacity building award contracts Begin contract monitoring and reporting Assess state legislative activity to determine whether more complete EDI implementation is feasible
