1	AN ORDINANCE establishing bond amounts for certain		
2	officers and employees of King County; and adding a new		
3	chapter to K.C.C. Title 3.		
4	PREAMBLE:		
5	King County is a home rule charter county under Article XI, Section 4 of		
6	the Washington State Constitution.		
7	The King County Charter properly designates county officers and		
8	employees necessary to carry out functions of the county.		
9	RCW 2.32.180 and 36.16.050 require some county officers and employees		
10	to post official bonds conditioned on faithful performance of the officer's		
11	or employee's official duties.		
12	RCW 3.34.090 and 36.16.050 gives the county council authority to set		
13	bond amounts for certain county officers and employees.		
14	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:		
15	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this ordinance should constitute a new chapter in		
16	K.C.C. Title 3.		
17	NEW SECTION. SECTION 2.		
18	A.1. County officers and employees specified in this section shall, before		
19	commencing duties of their office, coordinate with the office of risk management		

20	services to furnish official bonds conditioned on faithfully performing the duties of their	
21	offices. The bonds shall be in the following amounts:	
22	Assessor	\$50,000.00
23	Chief medical examiner	\$5,000.00
24	Councilmember	\$25,000.00
25	Director of elections	\$10,000.00
26	Director of the department of judicial administration	\$100,000.00
27	Executive	\$25,000.00
28	Manager of records and licensing services division	\$10,000.00
29	Prosecuting attorney	\$5,000.00
30	Sheriff	\$50,000.00
31	Treasurer	\$100,000.00
32	Each district court judge, district court judge pro	\$20,000.00
33	tempore, district court commissioner, clerk of the	
34	district court, and court employee	
35	Official court reporters, including reporters pro tempore	\$2,000.00
36	for the superior court	
37	2. The bonds required in subsection A.1. of this section may b	e satisfied by a
38	blanket bond assuring coverage at an amount not less than stated above	. The cost of any
39	such bond shall be borne by the county.	
40	B. The bonds in subsection A. of this section shall be furnished	by a surety
41	company authorized to do business in this state. Each bond shall be val	id for the officer's

42	full term, subject to earlier termination if the bonded officer leaves office. If the officer is		
43	not an elected official, the bond shall be valid until cancelled.		
44	C. The bonds in subsection A shall be filed with the director of the department of		
45	judicial administration, except the bond of the director of the department of judicial		
46	administration shall be filed with the treasurer.
