Dear Councilmember Upthegrove:

This letter transmits a proposed Ordinance that would, if enacted, ratify a memorandum of agreement (MOA) between King County (the County) and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 77 (the Union), representing employees in the Metro Transit Department (MTD), for a contractual period commencing on January 1, 2025, through and including December 31, 2025. Adoption of this proposed Ordinance will give employees in the Local 77 bargaining unit an additional 1.5 percent cost of living adjustment (COLA) in 2025.

This MOA covers approximately 105 electrical workers in the Facilities and Rail Divisions of MTD. The employees in these positions support Metro and Sound Transit with electrification of the bus operations as well as maintaining the link light rail through daily use and expansion.

The Union participates in the Joint Labor Management Insurance Committee (JLMIC), which is comprised of representatives of the County and labor organizations. Medical plan changes for 2025 were negotiated in the JLMIC resulting in an agreement covering benefits effective January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025. As a result, the County and the Union met to discuss changes in the health benefits plans as well as the 2025 compensation package for the bargaining unit. The discussions resulted in an agreement on changes to the current collective bargaining agreement (CBA).

The change to the CBA provides that in addition to the COLA formula already agreed to in the CBA, each member of the bargaining unit will receive an additional 1.5 percent general wage increase effective January 1, 2025.

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A complete breakdown of the costs associated with this agreement can be found in the accompanying fiscal note, which has been reviewed by the Office of Performance, Strategy and Budget. Supplemental budget authority is not needed for this agreement.
