SUMMARY

Proposed Motion 2011-0463 would authorize the Council Chair to enter into a contract amendment extending for an additional year the contract for services with Two Medicine Communications to represent the County with the Washington State Legislature, specifying the compensation to be paid during the extended term of the contract, and adding contract terms for further extension of the contract at the option of the County and for either party to request a price adjustment.

The motion has not yet been referred to committee; therefore, it is not yet ready for action and is before the committee for discussion only.

BACKGROUND

Because the County's services, operations, and finances are to a significant extent controlled by the laws of the state, legislation passed by the Washington State Legislature often has an impact on the County. Hence, it is in the interest of the residents of King County to have representation during the legislative session on a broad range of complex issues.

To provide such representation, the County conducted a competitive solicitation process, in which Two Medicine Communications Public Affairs Consulting (TMC) was the highest ranked proposer. TMC therefore was been chosen to represent King County with state government officials.

The initial term of the County's contract with TMC runs for one year, from 1 January 2011 through 31 December 2011. Since TMC has been representing the County well, the County has negotiated an amendment to the contract that would extend it to cover the period from 1 January 2012 through 31 December 2012 at the same rate of compensation, which is not to exceed \$131,200 for the year. The amendment would also add language to the contract (a) permitting the extension of the contract, at the county's option, for a third year at the same rate of compensation, and (b) permitting either party

to request "[r]easonable price changes based on market conditions and price/cost analysis."

THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Proposed Motion 2011-0463 would authorize the Council Chair to sign the amendment.

- Extend the duration of services to include State Government Relations Advocacy from 1/1/2012 12/31/2012. The total compensation for this contract extension is \$131,200.00.
- Amend Article II of the Contract to add the language found in Section 2 of Q in RFP.

Term Service Requirement – Contract Extension

The initial contract period will be for one (1) year from the start date of the contract. The term of the contract may be extended in one (1) year increments for two (2) additional one-year periods for a total contract duration of three (3) years, in accordance with the County's best interest and at the sole option of the County. Prices shall remain firm for the duration of the contract period. Reasonable price changes based on market conditions and price/cost analysis may be requested, if such escalations are based on changes in the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers ("CPI-U") for the Seatte-Tacoma-Bremerton Statistical Metropolitan Area for the preceding calendar year. You may obtain information about the CPI-U in general and the Seatte area in particular by visiting the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics web site at http://ww.bls.gov/cpil. In the event the CPI-U (or a successor or substitute index) is no longer published, a reliable government or other nonpartisan index of inflation selected by the County shall be used to calculate any adjusted amounts. Requests for any such changes are to be made in writing to the King County Council and approved by the County Executive or his/her designee. Any agreed-to change shall take effect at the time of the contract extension and shall remain in effect throughout the extension period. The parties hereto recognize that such changes could be increases or decreases in the prices; both parties are entitled to benefit from such price changes.
