1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2021-0155, VERSION 2**

2 On page 9, beginning on line 183, strike everything through line 193 and insert:

3 "S. The council finds that the COVID-19 pandemic has intensified the risk of
4 domestic and sexual violence and increased the need for domestic and sexual violence
5 services due to, among other things, the impact of stay-at-home orders contributing to
6 social isolation, separating survivors from their support networks, reducing the time
7 survivors have away from their abusers and diminishing access to childcare services,
8 food and education, as well as increased financial stress on families that can lead to
9 violence. The pandemic also has increased the severity and number of behavioral health
10 symptoms experienced by people across the county due to far-reaching medical,
11 economic, social and political consequences. The council therefore also finds that
12 additional funds for domestic and sexual violence and behavioral health services are
13 appropriate to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic and its negative economic impacts.
14 Domestic and sexual violence services may include behavioral health - trauma recovery
15 services and housing stability services utilizing the Domestic Violence Housing First
16 model to help domestic and sexual violence survivors address barriers to housing
17 stability."
