1 AN ORDINANCE changing the name of South King Fire
2 and Rescue to South King Fire.

3 **STATEMENT OF FACTS:**

4 1. South King Fire and Rescue, a fire district in the state of Washington,
5 desires to change its name to South King Fire.

6 2. The South King Fire and Rescue board of commissioners adopted
7 Resolution No. 628, which was filed with the King County council on
8 March 30, 2023, resolving to change the name to South King Fire in
9 accordance with RCW 52.30.060.

10 3. RCW 52.30.060 provides that the name of a fire protection district shall
11 be changed as proposed by resolution of the board of fire commissioners
12 of the district, upon approval of the change by the county legislative
13 authority of the county in which all, or the largest portion, of a fire
14 protection district is located.

15 4. South King Fire and Rescue Resolution No. 628 indicates that the
16 district desires to change the name to South King Fire to make the official
17 corporate and legal name match what has been used by the district for
18 many years.

19 5. The clerk of the council received a copy of South King Fire and Rescue
20 Resolution No. 628 on March 30, 2023.


22 SECTION 1. The King County council, under RCW 52.30.060, approves the

23 change in name of South King Fire and Rescue to South King Fire.



RESOLUTION NO. 628

**A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of South King Fire and Rescue,
Proposing that the Legal Name and Corporate Name of the District be Changed to
“South King Fire”, Subject to Approval of the King County Council,
Pursuant to RCW 52.30.060**

WHEREAS, South King Fire and Rescue desires to change its name to “South King Fire”;

WHEREAS, RCW 52.30.060 provides: "The name of a fire protection district shall be changed, as proposed by resolution of the board of fire commissioners of the district, upon the adoption of a resolution approving the change by the county legislative authority of the county in which all, or the largest portion, of a fire protection district is located"; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners desires to make the name that has been used for many years the official corporate and legal name of the district because the Board desires to avoid any confusion in the electorate, and because it would cost a substantial amount to change the name on all apparatus and stations, without any benefit to the public;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.


The Board of Commissioners hereby proposes that the District's corporate name and legal name be officially and legally changed to "South King Fire", effective upon the effective date of a resolution approving the change, adopted and filed by the King County Council.

Section 2.

The District Secretary is hereby directed to forward this resolution to the King County Council, with an explanatory cover letter, and with a request that the matter be acted upon by the Council at their earliest opportunity, and that the County Council advise the Fire District, and all pertinent King County departments of its action.

This resolution only purports to change the name of South King Fire & Rescue to “South King Fire” and shall not in any other manner impact the legal effect of Resolution 396 adopted on the 21st day of July 2005.







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Electronic Record and Signature Disclosure
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If you decide to receive notices and disclosures from us electronically, you may at any time change your mind and tell us that thereafter you want to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format. How you must inform us of your decision to receive future notices and disclosure in paper format and withdraw your consent to receive notices and disclosures electronically is described below.

Consequences of changing your mind

If you elect to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format, it will slow the speed at which we can complete certain steps in transactions with you and delivering services to you because we will need first to send the required notices or disclosures to you in paper format, and then wait until we receive back from you your acknowledgment of your receipt of such paper notices or disclosures. Further, you will no longer be able to use the DocuSign system to receive required notices and consents electronically from us or to sign electronically documents from us.

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Unless you tell us otherwise in accordance with the procedures described herein, we will provide electronically to you through the DocuSign system all required notices, disclosures, authorizations, acknowledgements, and other documents that are required to be provided or made available to you during the course of our relationship with you. To reduce the chance of you inadvertently not receiving any notice or disclosure, we prefer to provide all of the required notices and disclosures to you by the same method and to the same address that you have given us. - ii. send us an email to cipriano.dacanay@kingcounty.gov and in the body of such request you must state your email, full name, mailing address, and telephone number. We do not need any other information from you to withdraw consent.. The consequences of your withdrawing consent for online documents will be that transactions may take a longer time to process..
