In accordance with the Washington State Growth Management Act, King County hereby notifies the Department of Commerce of its intent to amend the King County Code relating to the Transportation Concurrency Management Program.

The King County Executive is proposing an ordinance to amend King County's Transportation Concurrency Management Program (enacted by King County Code 14.70) by adopting a new 2012 Transportation Concurrency Map and Transportation Concurrency Travel Shed Boundaries map update. The proposed ordinance and maps are attached, and electronic files will be sent to you shortly.

The King County Executive will transmit this proposed ordinance to the King County Council in September 2012. I anticipate the proposed ordinance will be acted upon by the King County Council in the fall of 2012. The ordinance can be tracked on the following website:
