7 WHEREAS, according to that motion, members of the advisory panel shall be
8 experts in residential construction, real estate, agriculture and forestry practices, fire
9 safety, environmental policy, rural and urban affairs in unincorporated King County, and

10 WHEREAS, in accordance with that ordinance, nominations for appointments
11 were provided to the executive by the Master Builders Association of King and
12 Snohomish Counties, the Seattle-King County Association of Realtors, the King County
13 Fire Chiefs Association and the Unincorporated Area Councils. In addition, the
14 executive was responsible for nominating the King County department of development
15 and environmental services representative, the environmental representative and the
16 agriculture and forestry representative. The senior deputy ombudsman for rural affairs is
17 named in the ordinance;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


19 The county executive's appointment of Roni Strupat, to the King County permit
