7 safety; adult detention; juvenile justice and youth services; superior and district courts;
8 judicial administration; prosecuting attorney; public defense; emergency medical
9 services; and emergency management, including disaster response, emergency
10 preparedness and emergency planning; and

11 WHEREAS, the law, justice, health and human services committee is charged
12 with considering and making recommendations on policies relating to public health
13 programs, including those related to the protection, promotion and provision functions of
14 the department of public health, including the structure of the public health centers; and

15 WHEREAS, the law, justice, health and human services committee is charged
16 with considering and making recommendations on policies relating to: human services
17 programs, including review of the veterans and human services levy programs and

18 options for levy renewal; therapeutic and low-income housing; and civil rights and social
19 justice; and

20 WHEREAS, the law, justice, health and human services committee is charged
21 with tracking state and federal legislative action in the areas within the committee's
22 purview, the committee shall develop recommendations on policy direction for 2010
23 annual budget, and

24 WHEREAS, the purpose of the law, justice, health and human services committee
25 work program is to guide committee work, providing the public and members of the
26 committee with a schedule for anticipated legislation and briefings and tentative dates for
27 their consideration, and

28 WHEREAS, the law, justice, health and human services committee work program
29 is intended to assist the committee's primary and secondary chairs in developing agendas
30 and assigning work to staff;


