NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 12th day of May, 2014, at 1:30 p.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2014-0128, which will enable the county to sell a surplus 1.53-acre Metro Transit Division property to the City of Bellevue.

SUMMARY

King County is proposing this ordinance to sell a surplus 1.53 acre parcel located in County Council District Six at 11101 NE 6th Street, Bellevue, WA 98004 to the City of Bellevue. This is a vacant parcel in the northeast corner of the block containing the Bellevue City Hall (cross streets N.E. 6th Street and 112th Avenue N.E.). The City of Bellevue intends to use the property for construction staging related to Sound Transit's East Link Project and eventually to convey a portion of the property to Sound Transit for use as a Light Rail station. This public hearing is being held in accordance with K.C.C. 4.56.140 and RCW 39.33.020.
