Reichbauer, Patterson, Gossett, Hague and Lambert A MOTION authorizing the chair of the council to extend 1 2 the contract for services with the Ferguson Group to 3 represent the county during 2007. 4 5 WHEREAS, the county is a subdivision of the state of Washington, and 6 7 WHEREAS, the county's services, operations and finances are to a significant 8 extent controlled by the actions of the state and federal governments, and 9 WHEREAS, the actions of the United States Congress affect the county's 10 services, operations and finances, and 11 WHEREAS, the grants, proposals and actions of the federal executive branch 12 affect the delivery of services to the citizens of King County, and WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the residents of the county for the county to 13 14 have representation during the United States 110th Congress, 1st session, on a broad 15 range of complex issues, and 16 WHEREAS, the Ferguson Group has successfully met and exceeded every 17 contractual requirement within the original contract with the county, and

18	WHEREAS, the Ferguson Group would provide the high level of expertise
19	needed to represent the county during 2007 and including the United States 110th
20	Congress, 1st session, and
21 .	WHEREAS, Motion 10651, Section III, as amended, and OR 1-020 require
22	council authorization by motion for the council chair to sign contracts in excess of
23	twenty-five thousand dollars;
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
25	The chair of the metropolitan King County council is hereby authorized to extend
26	the contract with the Ferguson Group, on the same terms as the existing contract, in an
27	amount not to exceed two hundred and forty-nine thousand dollars, for the following
28	services in 2007 representing King County before the 1st session of the United States
29	110th Congress:
30	A. Representing the county before and monitoring actions by Congress and the
31	federal administration; and
