The regional water quality committee seeks to understand the **relative rate burden** **cumulative impact** of the proposed annual sewer rate across **rate payers** **agencies** and between generations of rate payers, **since the inception of the contract through current projection periods**. Additionally, through this review **of the annual rate**, the update to the regional wastewater services plan, and other adopted county policies, the committee will seek to identify those policies impacting the sewer rate and capacity charge that might benefit from interjurisdictional discussion held in the regional water quality committee.
