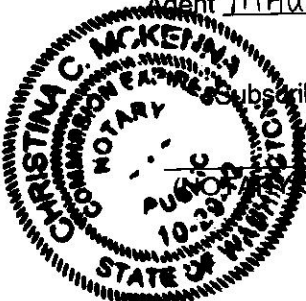

NOTICE OF ADOPTION
Ordinance No. 17287**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council), on March 19, 2012 beginning at 1:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA), after holding a public hearing to consider Proposed Substitute Ordinance 2011-0227 (Ordinance 17287) which would establish a demonstration project to evaluate a master planning process, adopted Ordinance 17287. Public testimony was also taken at public hearings on, December 5, 2011, February 21, 2012, and March 5, 2012.

SUMMARY:

Ordinance 17287 authorizes a demonstration project for the purpose of testing a master planning process to be used for the review of a potential expansion at Pacific Raceways and includes provisions that:

- c Limit the demonstration project to the Pacific Raceways site,
- c Allow consideration of uses that would support the primary activities of the raceway,
- c Outline the requirements for application submittal,
- c Specify the minimum requirements for an agreement that controls future development and operations of the site,
- c Require screening of buildings and racing surfaces from adjacent properties,
- c Require compliance with specific criteria in order to impact critical areas,

- c Require compliance with surface water management standards,
- c Require site improvements and designs for reducing noise impacts,
- c Establish a specific timeline for project review,
- c Allow the council to use the King County Hearings Examiner as a fact-finder,
- c Establish an effective period and provisions for extension of the effective period,
- c Require on-going monitoring and reporting,
- c Require a report evaluating the master planning process,
- c Require the preparation of an environmental impact statement by an independent consultant, and
- c Outline the process for consultant selection and consultant responsibilities
