

- 20 community conversations
- 20 focus groups/ listening sessions including meetings with senior center leadership
- 15+ informational presentations
- 10 open houses
- Translated outreach materials in Amharic,
  Arabic, Chinese, Korean, Russian, Somali,
  Spanish, Tagalog, Ukrainian, and Vietnamese.
- Interpretation and translation including in American Sign Language and Computer Assisted Real-time Translation offered at meetings.

### Areas of Focus for 2024-2029 Select Highlighted Strategies



FS 1 – King County Veterans Program

Continue building the nation's strongest local veterans program through KCVP with low-barrier, specialized outreach and resource connection.



SS 9 – Resource Access Team

Dedicate county staff to strengthen resident and resource connections making it easier for residents to access the services they need.



HS 2 – Veterans Facility Capital and Operations

Secure an affordable housing veterans facility, paired with housing navigation and connections in other strategies to continue reducing veteran homelessness

SE 1 – Support Senior Centers

Stabilize and transform senior centers as inclusive, vibrant places that serve as access points to critical services for the full diversity of seniors in the community.
