NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council will hold a public hearing in the King County Council Chambers, 10th Floor, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington on Monday November 7, 2016 at 11:00 a.m. The purpose of this hearing is to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance No. 2016-0475, which will adopt the 2017-2018 King County Capital Improvement Program (CIP). The CIP becomes the capital facilities component of the King County Comprehensive Plan and is adopted as an amendment to the 2017-2022 King County CIP, as adopted by the County Council, will satisfy the Growth Management Act requirement to provide a six-year plan that will finance capital facilities within projected funding capacities and clearly identify sources of public money for those capital facilities.

SUMMARY

The CIP budget for the 2017-2018 biennium is \$2.368 billion. Of the \$2.368 billion proposed to be budgeted for 2017-2018, \$627 million is for the Wastewater Treatment capital program and \$565 million is proposed for Public Transportation bus and van pool vehicle replacement.
