1 A MOTION appointing committees to write the voters'
2 pamphlet statements for and against the charter amendment
3 placed on the ballot by Ordinance 16884 for the November
4 2, 2010, election.

5 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of
6 local voters' pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of chapter 29A.32 RCW for
7 annual general elections held in King County, and

8 WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a unit of
9 local government that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of
10 that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating
11 voter approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter
12 rejection of the measure, and

13 WHEREAS, Ordinance 16884, passed by the council on July 19, 2010, provided
14 for submission to the voters at the November 2, 2010, general election of a charter
15 amendment that would amend the Preamble of the King County Charter to specify the
16 local and regional role of county government and clarify the purposes of county
17 government;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

19 Pursuant to RCW 29A.32.280, the following individuals are appointed to serve on
20 the voters' pamphlet committees for the charter amendment proposed in Ordinance
21 16884, each committee to write a statement for or against the proposed amendment, for
22 the 2010 general election:




