I'm requesting appointment to the vacancy of commissioner, Position 2, King County Water District #125. I served previously as commissioner, Position 3, in this district (125) continuously from January 1, 1986 until I resigned effective May 1, 2002. The reasons for my resignation were twofold. First, I was retiring from The Boeing Company; and secondly, I felt the direction one of the sitting commissioners was trying to push the district was contrary to my way of thinking. Rather than to cause further strife within Walter District prior to the end of my third elected term. At the time of my departure, I chose to leave that the district remained in good hands under the direction of then board president, John Thompson, a man I greatly respect both professionally and personally.
