NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1200, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 1st day of October, 2018, at 1:30 p.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2018-0373, an ordinance relating to the secure storage of firearms; adding a new chapter to K.C.C. Title 12 and prescribing penalties.

### SUMMARY

Proposed Ordinance 2018-0373 would make it unlawful for any person in unincorporated King County to keep a firearm, whether loaded or unloaded with ammunition, within any premise unless the firearm is safely stored in or using a secure firearm storage or safety device and prescribe penalties.

Any person in violation of the proposed ordinance shall first be given a warning in writing by a law enforcement officer and the law enforcement officer shall inform the person of nearby facilities where a secure firearm storage or safety device may be purchased. A violation of the proposed ordinance, fifteen days after the initial warning constitutes a civil infraction not to exceed one thousand dollars and the notice of infraction shall be issued by a law enforcement officer.

If a person provides evidence that a secure firearm storage or safety device has been obtained since the issuance of the notice of infraction, then the civil infraction shall be waived by the court. The law enforcement officer shall inform the person of this provision after issuance of the notice of infraction.
