THE MIGHT OF NATURE, THE state's highest award for public service. In his long and eventful life, he had served on the state Parks and Recreation Commission and an array of boards and committees. He was dedicated to economic development, good schools, better roads and open government.

In 2013, Woods was a featured speaker at the opening of "Grand Coulee to Grunge: Eight stories that changed the world," an exhibit created by the agency's Legacy Washington team. "Wife's father, Rufus Woods, was a tireless booster of Grand Coulee

WE WERE TO HAVE A HEAVY treasure in our midst. He was the youngest 95-year-old I'd ever met."

The Woodses, with the Blehens of The Seattle Times, were also featured in Pressing On, a Legacy Washington book about the last family-owned newspapers in America.

Once asked about the secret to his longevity, Woods noted that he relished his daily 17-mile walk from his office to the production facility to get one of the first papers off the press. But sooner or later, he said his number would be up. "That's life. That's the way life goes."
