A. GENERAL INFORMATION

Petitioner(s): Alexis and Devin Jones, and Garth Cook

B. HISTORY AND OVERVIEW

R.C.W. 36.87 establishes the right of property owners to petition a county legislative body for the vacation of road rights-of-way. K.C.C. 14.40 establishes King County policies and procedures for accomplishing same.

The petition was filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on September 24, 2025, by Devin and Alexis Jones, Garth Cook, and Casey and Melody Olson seeking the vacation of a portion of County Road No. 393/SJ Twiss Road in the Enumclaw area of unincorporated King County. The Olsons have since sold their property to the Joneses and are no longer part of the petition. Casey Olson notified the Hearing Examiner of this on May 8, 2026, and assigned the Olsons' petitioner status to the Joneses. This notification is included as Exhibit 19.

The subject right-of-way is a portion of a County Road that was established in 1894 and amended in 1904. No records were located indicating use, improvement or maintenance of the area by King County and it is unclear whether a road was ever built in the area that the petition seeks to vacate.

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The petitioners own all the lands abutting the requested vacation area. The subject portion of right-of-way qualifies as unopened and unmaintained county road right-of-way (See Exhibit 9).

C. NOTICE

Notice of this hearing was posted at the approximate ends of the proposed vacation area on May 22, 2026, see Exhibit 20, and published in accordance with requirements of RCW 36.87.060, see Exhibit 21.

D. REVIEWING AGENCIES AND COMMENTS

The King County Department of Local Services, Road Services Division (“Roads”) solicited comments from agencies within King County and utilities serving the area regarding the impacts of vacating the area.

Puget Sound Energy (PSE), Comcast and Lumen were contacted as part of the Agency Review process. PSE and Lumen replied and no objections were raised.

King County Department of Local Services Permitting Division raised concerns about the potential landlocking of the parcels to the north that currently have access via an easement which also traverses the right of way proposed for vacation. These parcels are identified by King County parcel numbers 132006-9281, -9280, -9279, and -9079, and are all under the ownership of petitioner Garth Cook. Upon approval of the vacation petition, Mr. Cook will have control of access to each of his properties. Mr. Cook has said that he will sign a letter accepting the land-locked condition of these parcels after the vacation, should it be approved. No property not a party to this road vacation petition will be landlocked as a result of approval of the petition.

Another concern was raised by the King County Department of Local Services Bridge Unit that this vacation would not benefit the public. From Roads’ standpoint, the approval of this petition will reduce maintenance responsibilities and potential liabilities by vacating an area that has been determined to have no use to the County Road system and this constitutes a public benefit. The determination of compensation for vacated areas of right of way relies on a valuation from the King County Assessor and the Office of Performance, Strategy and Budget formula. The worksheets are included as Exhibits 12-14.

Roads did not receive responses from Comcast; Enumclaw Fire Department; Department of Executive Services, Property Services; Department of Natural Resources and Parks, Open Space, Water and Land Resource Division, and Wastewater; Department of Local Services, Roads Services – Maintenance, King County Metro, and the Department of Executive Services – Historical Preservation.

A copy of the Notice is included as Exhibit 10.

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E. COMPENSATION

Roads obtained from the King County Assessor's Office a determination of value for the areas proposed for vacation associated with each of the Petitioner's properties and the area that will attach to a non-petitioning property if the petition to vacate is approved. These amounts are shown on the table following:

The Assessor's Office determined that adding approximately 11,432 square feet to the Petitioners' Parcel 132006-9282 would result in a \$4,000 increase in value. The valuation as applied to the PSB model results in no additional charge of compensation from Petitioners should the approximately 11,432 square foot area of unopened undeveloped right-of-way be vacated. See Exhibit 12.

As to Parcel 132006-9283, the Assessor's Office determined that adding approximately 7,728 square feet to the parcel would result in a \$1,000 increase in value. The valuation as applied to the PSB model results in no additional charge of compensation from Petitioners should the approximately 7,728 square foot area of unopened undeveloped right-of-way be vacated. See Exhibit 13.

As to Parcel 182007-9042, the Assessor's Office determined that adding approximately 2,740 square feet to the parcel would result in a \$3,000 increase in value. The valuation as applied to the PSB model results in no additional charge of compensation from Petitioners should the approximately 2,740 square foot area of unopened undeveloped right-of-way be vacated. See Exhibit 14.

F. COUNTY ROAD ENGINEER RECOMMENDATION

The County Road Engineer has determined that the subject portion of right-of-way is useless to the county transportation system and that Petition V-2776 seeking to vacate this portion of County Road No. 393/SJ Twiss Road should be approved, subject to written acknowledgement from Petitioner Garth Cook that he accepts the land-locked condition of the other parcels under his ownership after the vacation.

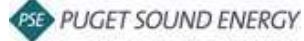

Devin and Alexis Jones, Garth Cook, and Casey and Melody Olson have petitioned King County to vacate a portion of County Road 393, located north of SE 424th Street, a short distance to the west of 276th Place SE, in the Enumclaw area of unincorporated King County. The King County Department of Local Services, Road Services Division's County Road Engineer (CRE) has been directed by the Clerk of the King County Council to examine the road and issue a report and recommendation as to whether the right-of-way should be vacated. However, before a report can be made, the CRE needs your comments or recommendations regarding any interest you may have in the subject right-of-way.

Currently, it takes approximately one year to 18 months to complete the road vacation process. King County Road Services Division is working hard to reduce the length of time it takes to process the petition to vacate a county road. 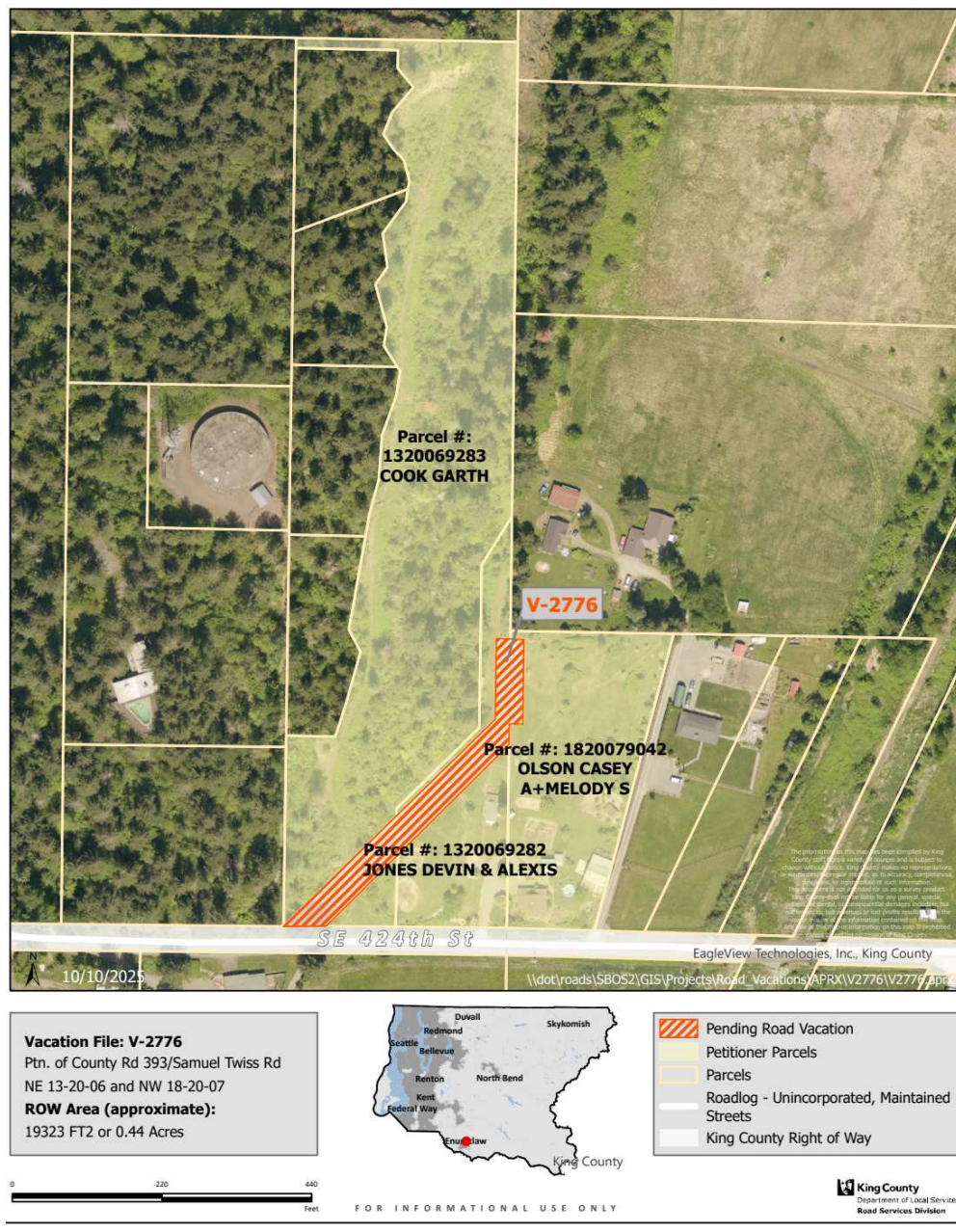
