Narrative:

Over fifty children live and play in the area. Area residents have experienced numerous problems with hunters trespassing, poaching, and shooting guns through yards where children were playing less than 100 feet from homes. Despite neighborhood hunter watch efforts and several calls to local police and game wardens, these problems persist. Please grant this request to give us a tool to discourage these dangerous practices.
