NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council adopted Ordinance 17513 on January 22, 2013. King County provides this notice of adoption and enactment pursuant to RCW 36.70A.290(2)(b).

SUMMARY

Ordinance 17513 relates to the King County transportation concurrency management program, adopting a new concurrency map and an updated travel shed boundaries map. The concurrency map is a tool for ensuring that King County's transportation infrastructure is adequate to meet the needs of new development. The concurrency map identifies which travel sheds throughout unincorporated King County pass or fail the concurrency test, as measured by travel time standards applied to each travel shed. A proposed development must be in a passing travel shed as an initial step in the project development process. The concurrency map was generated by travel time data collected in spring 2012 and applied to travel speed standards in the King County Code. This map replaces the current transportation concurrency map adopted in February 2011. A revised travel shed boundaries map illustrates travel sheds used in concurrency testing and is updated to account for recent annexations. The travel shed boundaries map accounts for recent annexations and replaces the current map adopted in January 2012.
